



***Dr Nagy's TMD and ICR
Progressive Condylar Resorption
Check List***

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If you see an anterior open bite, especially a progressing class II anterior open bite - screen for ICR/Progressive Condylar Resorption

- Full Orthodontic records, scans, xrays (PAN, Ceph, TMJ xray, FMX).
- Rheumatoid Arthritis Blood Test
 - Rheumatoid factor
 - CCP Antibody IGG
 - ESR – erythrocyte sedimentation Rate
 - CRP – C-Reactive Protein
- MRI - Take image of the TMJ complex with open, and with closed bite with no contrast, with interpretations. (Get the closes hospital's info, and fax the MRI order in directly)

- Sleep Study/OSA: _____

- Bone scan if any: SPECT, or Tech99
